Remarks: All Radiological Control Signs and barriers **MUST ABSOLUTELY BE OBEYED**. Film badges or TLD badges must be worn at all times in Controlled Areas. This work must be done between the hours of 7:00 am and 3:30 pm Monday through Friday. If work is required to be done outside of the specified times, Steve Downey (pager 4-1523), Ed Russell (pager 630-252-7717), or John Vacca (2-6180) must be notified at least 8 hours in advance.

IF WORK IS TO BE DONE IN A CONTROLLED AREA:

- 1. All tools and equipment used in the APS tunnels and rings are to be surveyed by Health Physics personnel before they can be removed from those areas.
- 2. Any parts of the system that have been exposed to operating conditions must be surveyed before removal from the areas stated above.
- 3. If the place of work has a radiation sticker or posting, contact Health Physics personnel **BEFORE** starting the work.
- 4. Personnel without General Employee Radiation Training (GERT) must have a visitor's film badge and must be escorted.
- 5. No work is permitted by anyone on the roof of an experimental station if beam is in the station. If access/work is required on the roof, contact the Floor Coordinator (4-0101) or Health Physics (2-6180).
- 6. No work is permitted on the sides, rear, or front that will involve any change in the shielding integrity of the experimental station. If work is required on the sides, rear, or front, contact the Floor Coordinator (4-0101) or Health Physics (2-6180).
- 7. HEALTH PHYSICS MUST BE CONTACTED BEFORE THIS AREA CAN BE ENTERED

Note: Contractors are not allowed to bring radiation sources to Argonne without Argonne's Health Physics approval. HEALTH PHYSICS CAN BE CONTACTED AT EXTENSION 2-6180
