Next Steps in Strategic Planning

- APS management will prepare a draft
 5-year strategic plan for discussion at the January '05 SAC meeting
 - Will seek comments from APS Users and the APS Partner User Organization
- After SAC input, the strategic plan will be publicly released in early 2005
- Output of workshops will be published in reports in the next ~ six months

What the plan doesn't do

- Close the door to other new ideas
- APS does not have the resources to make all this happen
 - We will use our resources as best we can in the context of the plan
 - e.g., beamline personnel, IDs, XOR equipment, accelerator development
 - We will use this plan to make the case for additional resources
 - We will seek partnering with outside institutions

The process to build new beamlines at the APS

- Proposal driven
- SAC advises APS management on approval
 - Letter Of Intent (LOI)
 - Scientific Proposal
 - Conceptual Design
 - Management Plan
 - Funds
- Strategic planning is also intended to stimulate development of LOIs from external partners...

Budget and resources

- FY 2005 will be a challenging year (flat budget)
- However, Interagency Working Group on synchrotrons, and BES, making concerted progress on "Utilization Factor" approach to emphasize needs for beamline construction and operation – OMB/OSTP are very supportive -> influence '06 or '07 budgets (APS budget from ~\$96M to \$130M)

trepidation and hope...

Transverse RF kick for 1 ps pulse generation at APS

- A very exciting method discussed at workshop on time-domain science to create ~1ps pulses at APS
- A feasibility study, under the auspices of the Operations Directorate, is going on now, with Denny Mills as Chair
- Menu of feasible options will lead to good decision making based on science needs
