

## **Funding**



- Senate appropriates +\$20M in FY'06 to BES for facility operations
- House appropriates +\$19.7M for same purpose

#### **APS 2010**

- ANL and DOE encourage improvements and increased resources to APS
- Short-term (FY'07) Aim at a package of smaller projects, beamlines, detectors, accelerator enhancements, e.g., short-pulse option and improved stability EACH DELIVERING WORLD CLASS CAPABILITIES
- Strategic planning for larger upgrades in the next 5 years, including accelerator innovations
  - Revised timescale from APS 20 year plan

## Security is a serious business

### Event on 24-ID-C June 27, 2005

- User adjusted locknuts on a safety shutter for 24-ID-C, contravening APS policy
- Floor coordinator was made aware of problem, consulted others, but group took some time to decide that a revalidation was required
- One lesson learned STOP WORK
  AUTHORITY should be invoked automatically
  when procedures have been violated. Shoot first
  and ask questions later.
