

# Positive Budget for FY'07 but Challenging for FY'06




Total \$108.604M is a \$10.604M increase (12.05%) on the President's budget for FY 2006.

Operating \$98.741M; Capital \$4.385M; ARIM \$5.478M. Increase almost entirely in operating funds.

### **IPNS** Future

- IPNS expected to support neutron science as SNS comes into full operation (at least 3-5 years)
- Strategy for future beyond existing IPNS ops is being developed
  - Even a worst-case shut-down strategy can preserve neutron/x-ray science, accelerator research and engineering and assure continuity of the very successful IPNS team
- FY'07 budget announced for IPNS is very positive (+\$3M) and continued operation expected beyond FY'08
