

#### Issues


- Budget update
  - \$7.9M ARRA funds received
    - \$4.3M for detectors
    - \$3.6M for FEs and IDs sectors 13,16 and 34
  - Awaiting congressional conference action on FY2010 budget
    - ~\$10M increase slated in President's budget
- Renewal moving forward
  - No formal feedback yet, but expect CD-0 to be prepared soon
  - Planning for SAC meeting October 8-9
    - Kick-off Conceptual Design Report process
