The Festival, was the country's first national science festival, and was a collaboration of over 500 of the country's leading science and engineering organizations aimed at reigniting the interest of our nation's youth in the sciences. > 500 science and engineering organizations

> 400 science booths holding science demonstrations and exhibits

Spanned across the National Mall as well as occupied the Freedom Plaza, Wilson Plaza, and the National Museum of Natural History.

Estimated that over 1 million visitors attended during the 2 day weekend

President Obama invited the nation to the inaugural USA Science and Engineering Festival:

(1) Pre expo events (science competitions) held throughout the year

(2) The "grand finale" held at Washington DC

(3) 70 simultaneous satellite events held in towns and cities around the country.
