He received his Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering from Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 2004. Prior to joining Georgia Tech in 2005, he was a postdoctoral associate at Harvard University. His research centers around solid mechanics and materials modeling. He has received the Sia Nemat-Nasser Early Career Award and Materials Division Centennial Mid-Career Award from the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, as well as the Young Investigator Medal from the Society of Engineering Science.
