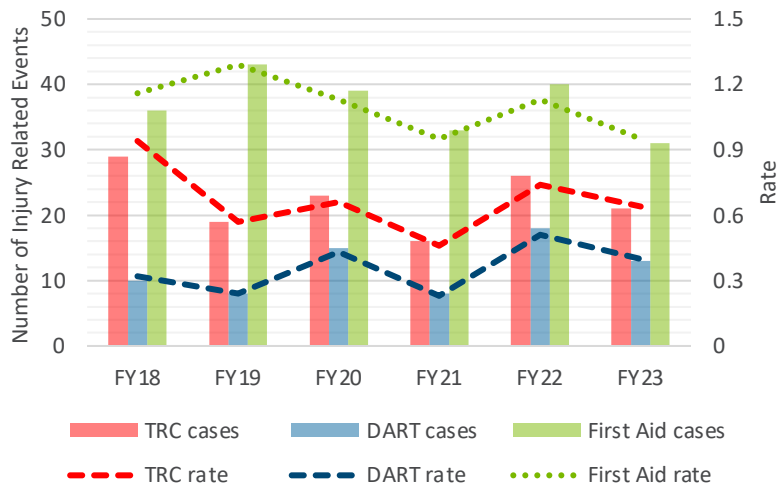

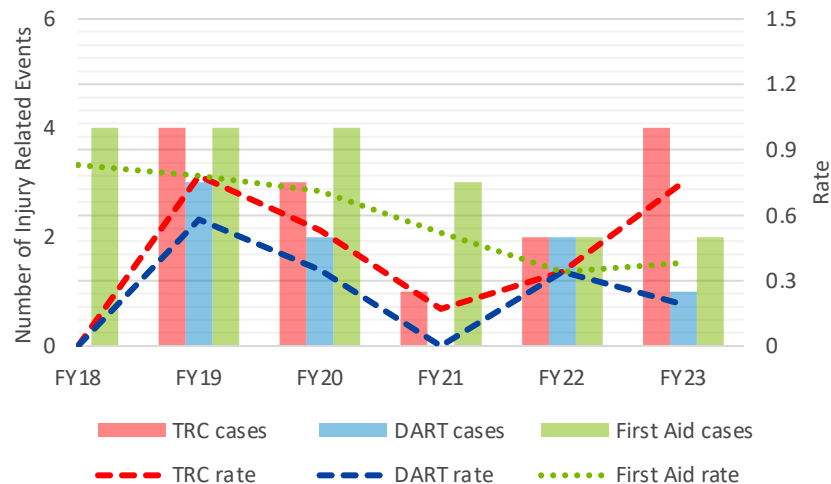
## Photon Sciences safety record for FY23 – 1 additional Recordable Case

# BE MINDFUL OF SAFETY – YOURS AND OTHERS
